Monday June 21, 2010 – Logger's Trail GC, Stillwater Minnesota **OR**
Friday June 25, 2010 – Braemar GC, Edina Minnesota

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This notice is intended to inform you of a few details prior to play in the local qualifier, and assist you in successfully qualifying for the Amateur Public Links Championship, to be held July 12-17 at Bryan Park Golf Club, in Greensboro NC.

Enclosed with this Notice is your starting time/pairing information for the qualifier you entered.

Travel to Local Qualifying Site: There may be road construction along the way to your course. Plan to be on-site at the qualifier at least 20 minutes prior to your starting time.

Footwear Policy: Use of metal spikes is prohibited at both Logger's Trail and Braemar golf courses.

Greens Fee: Players are responsible for the purchase of one greens fee at Logger's Trail (\$35.00) or Braemar (\$29.00) before starting.

Starting Times: There will be no change in the starting times established by the Committee other than by decision of the Committee due to weather conditions. Please check in with the USGA APL representative at the course and be prepared to report to your starting hole ten minutes prior to your starting time. If a player arrives at his starting hole within five minutes of his starting time, he will be penalized two strokes and allowed to play. If after five minutes, the penalty is disqualification.

Practice Range: The practice ranges at Logger's Trail and Braemar will be open one hour before the first starting time the morning of qualifying.

Food and Beverage Service: There are snack bars at both Logger's Trail and Braemar for food and beverage service throughout the day.

Dress Code: Please dress appropriately for competitive golf – no cutoffs, T-shirts, etc.

Caddies and Carts: You may bring your own caddie if you wish to use one, you may carry your own bag, or you may use a non-motorized walking cart.

Pace of Play: Pace of play will be monitored by on-course officials. Expected time to complete one round in the qualifiers is 4H 10M.

Conforming Ball Rule: The one-ball rule is in effect for the qualifiers. Plan to have enough of the same brand and model of golf balls with you. Penalty – Disqualification.

Electronic Devices: Distance measuring devices are not allowed. Penalty – Disqualification.

Local Rules: A local rules sheet will be available at your starting hole.

Conditions of the Competition: USGA Rules apply and are amended per the Local Rules sheet you will be issued.
