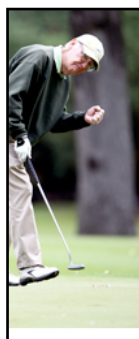


Registering for MGA Senior Tour Events Online



competitive tournaments for senior golfers, 55 years and older. What started with just one section with 230 golfers in 1996 has grown to five sections (Northern, Southern, Eastern, Western and Super Senior) with over 800 golfers in 2011. Each section is limited to 210 players and offers ten 18-hole individual play events hosted by courses in a regional area specific to the section except for the Super Senior section offering eight events primarily located in the metro area. A player may opt to play in ANY ONE of the sections regardless of where he lives, but he cannot play in more than one of the sections unless he is 70 years or older. Players 70 years old and up can have a Dual membership** in the Super Senior section and one of the other sections. There are also four all section events* for fun overnight trips hosted by clubs in a wide range of regions in the state.

*All section events are not open to Super Senior players unless they have a Dual membership in one of the other sections.

1. From the Senior Tour homepage

click on "[Online Registration](#)" and you will be taken to the MGA Online Registration Login screen.

2. From the Login screen

enter your existing username and password **OR** register if you are new to allow complete access to this site.

3. View Your Profile or Create Your Profile.

Verify that your profile information is correct by clicking on "Edit Profile" **OR** create your profile if registering for the first time.

4. Use the "Season Filter" to find "Senior Tour - SECTION Events" or "Senior Tour - TWO DAY Events" narrowing the event list down to just the current Senior Tour schedule.

5. Use the "Member Program Filter" to find your Senior Tour section narrowing the event list down to just your section's Senior Tour schedule. When viewing the TWO DAY Events schedule leave the "Member Program Filter" on "All."

• Click on event name

for event information.

• View status of entries

to see how full an event is becoming.

• Click on "Participants"

found on the far right side of each event line to see a list of registered players.

6. Select the event(s) you want to sign up for during each online session

by checking the box to the left of each event. Each selection will turn yellow and then click on the gray "Register for Selected Events" box at the top to take you through the final steps and payment process.

• Wait listed events can still be entered.

If you see an event has a wait list, you can still sign up and add your name to the wait list. Your payment for the wait listed event will not be processed unless you move into the event due to an opening. History has shown that we do get cancellations and can go through quite a few players on the wait list. Wait listed players will even be contacted up to the day of the event if there are any late cancellations.

7. You will receive an email confirmation for each of your selected and paid for events during each online session.
