LIFT, CLEAN PLACE: #1 Lift, Clean & Place within One Club Length anywhere in the General Area (does not have to stay in the same condition). #2 Once you finalize placing your ball under #1, you cannot touch it again. #3 If you are taking relief under another rule (such as immovable obstructions or penalty area), you are entitled to Lift, Clean & Place after taking relief.

EMBEDDED BALL: Rule 16.3

TEMPORARY WATER: Rule 16.1

SUSPENSION: 1) Lightning (dangerous condition), one long horn blast, repeated. Stop Play IMMEDIATELY. 2) Other Reasons, Three (3) short horn blasts, repeated. 3) Resumption of Play, Two (2) short horn blasts, repeated.

TEES: All play will be from the Blue tees (approx.: 6,198 yards).

SPOTS: Qualifiers: 11 Alternates: 3

TIES: In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or the alternate spot, an announcement will be made as to the playoff procedure. Options may include an on-course playoff or scorecard playoff.

RULES: The Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, Pace of Play Policy, and the following local rules govern play. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.

FORMAT: Two 9-hole rounds, stroke play. The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if, for any reason, the full 18 holes cannot be completed. If this happens, results will be based on 9-hole scores with the available spots divided accordingly in the event of a two-tee start.

ELECTRONIC SCORING: The official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the Golf Genius Mobile App. Paper scorecards will not be provided to players. Players should review the printed and video educational information posted on the qualifying webpage to prepare in advance for this process. Also, players should make sure their mobile devices are fully charged prior to beginning play. After completing your final hole, all players and their markers should go to the Scoring Area immediately to certify their scores.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences. Inside edge of pavement/curbing for roads or parking lot bordering the course.

PENALTY AREAS: Penalty Areas are defined by either RED or YELLOW stakes and/or lines. When both stakes and lines are used to mark a penalty area, the stakes identify the area, while the lines define the Penalty Area.

DROPPING ZONES: Local Rule E-1. There is a dropping zone on Hole #7 as an additional option for a ball in the maintenance area to the right of the fairway. Please disregard any other dropping zones that are marked on the course.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following define GUR: Model Local Rule F-7 – Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas – lie of ball and area of intended swing only.

PACE OF PLAY: The published MGA Pace of Play Policy is in effect.
