## Local Rules and Information Sheet

**RULES OF PLAY:** Play is governed by the USGA rules of golf, MGA local rules and conditions, and this notice. Ignore any Local Rules on the club scorecard

**TEES:** There are two sets of tees for this championship. Play is from the white MGA tee markers for the championship flight and from the red MGA tee markers for players in all other flights.

**FORMAT:** 36 holes gross stroke play for Championship and other flights excluding the Master Division, which is 36 holes net stroke play. (The event may be shortened due to extenuating circumstances.)

**POSTING OF SCORES:** The MGA *will be* posting scores to GHIN for handicap purposes.

**HOLE LOCATIONS:** Color of flags on flagstick. Red = front, White = middle, Blue = Back.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by white stakes, white lines, fences and the course-side edge of the road or sidewalk on holes 1, 3, 10, and 15.

**YELLOW PENALTY AREAS:** Yellow Penalty Areas are identified by yellow stakes and may be defined by yellow lines.

**RED PENALTY AREAS:** Red Penalty Areas are identified by red stakes and may be defined by red lines. 2 "Dropping Zones" have been established behind the 6th green. This is an additional option under Rule 17 for a ball that is in, or known or virtually certain to be in, the Penalty Area behind the 6th green. If the player uses this option, she must use the closest "Drop Zone" to where their ball cross the edge of the Penalty Area (even if this is closer to the hole).

**GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** White lined areas. All flower beds are GUR.

**OBSTRUCTIONS:** All cart paths whether artificially surfaced or not. Flower beds and/or rock formations adjacent to cart paths are considered part of the cart path.

**REST AREAS:** 4th tee, 8th tee, between 13/14 and the 17th tee.

**DRINKING WATER:** Bottle water will be provided in coolers throughout the golf course as well as at the turn (between 9 and 18).
