RULES AND INFORMATION: The USGA Rules of Golf, the MGA Rules Card, and all Local Rules established specifically for the Championship will be in effect. Players wanting the MGA Terms of Competition may find it on the MGA web site – www.mngolf.org - under the Tournament & Rules Section. Local Rules will be available on the event [landing page](#).

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Crow River Golf Club is a facility with practice rounds available by tee time arrangement in advance. Please call Crow River Golf Shop at (320) 587-3070 to schedule a practice round and identify yourself as a Minnesota State Junior Boys participant. Sunday practice round rates are discounted for participants, reservations can be made one week in advance. Adults may play with the junior at adult rates found on the [Crow River GC website](#).

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: Players are permitted to use distance measuring devices that measure distance only. Slope must be disabled.

PACE OF PLAY: The official MGA Pace of Play Policy will be in effect and is posted on our website.

PLAYER CONDUCT: The Rules Officials will strongly enforce a code of conduct for all players. Unbecoming conduct includes, but is not limited to the following:

- (1) Any use of loud profanity reported and collaborated will be penalized.
- (2) Any club throwing, club slamming or other disruptive behavior will be penalized.

Penalty for unbecoming conduct – ***two strokes***,

Penalty for repeated offense or a serious breach of player conduct - ***disqualification***.

approximately one hour after completion of the Second round.

PRACTICE RANGE: The practice range will open 60 minutes prior to the first starting time both days. Range balls are provided prior to your round and will be available on the range prior to your round. The driving range is limited to 200 yards. We will enforce **"no metal woods"** on the range. This will include any club that you can hit over 200 yards.

PLAYER MEALS: The MGA will provide each competitor with a meal at the club both Monday and Tuesday.

Monday and Tuesday meal service will be available from 11:00am through 2:00pm either before or after your round. Course personnel will have a list of players based on their starting times as a way of keeping track of meals received.

DRESS CODE: ***The dress code will be strictly enforced.*** For all MGA competitions, players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All players and caddies are required to wear shirts with collars and sleeves, and either golf slacks or Bermuda shorts. Examples of attire NOT ACCEPTABLE attire includes the following: short shorts, athletic shorts, tennis shorts, cut-offs, jeans, jean shorts, tank tops, t-shirts, sweatpants. The committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met and will withdraw the entry of the player who does not comply. A player is responsible for the attire of his caddie.

DIGITAL SCORING: Scoring will be done by use of the Golf Genius App. Players should have the app downloaded on their phones and be prepared to keep score. The player GGID will be sent via text and email to all players the night before each round using the cell phone number and email in his profile. Please check in with the registration table when you arrive at the course on Monday to show that you have completed this step.

CADDIES AND CARTS: Little Crow CC *does not* have caddies available. Players may walk carrying their own clubs or use a pull cart. Also, players are permitted the use of a caddie; however, a player **may not use a parent, step-parent, or guardian as a caddie** (This policy is established by the USGA for the US Junior Amateur Championship). Spectator Carts *will not* be allowed without a handicap placard. See an MGA Rules Official on site for permission to rent a riding cart.

AWARDS PRESENTATION: Immediately after the conclusion of the play, Wednesday, there will be an awards presentation. Awards will be given to the top 3 players. Ties for 2nd and 3rd will be retained and appropriate awards will be ordered.

ETIQUETTE: Please be courteous to your fellow competitors and the golf course by replacing divots, fixing ball marks, and raking bunkers.
