### Local Rules and Information Sheet

**TEES:** *Championship Men – BLUE* markers  
*Senior & Net Men – WHITE* markers

*Championship Women – GOLD* markers  
*Senior & Net Women – RED* markers

**FORMAT:** *Round 1:* Four-Ball, Stroke Play  
*Round 2:* Modified Chapman (Alternate shot)

Both partners play from each teeing ground, with each partner playing his or her partner's ball for the second shot. After the second shot, partners select the ball with which they wish to score and play that ball alternately to complete the hole.

NOTE: Penalty strokes DO NOT affect the order of play.

**PLAYOFF:** In the event of a tie for the Championship or Senior Championship (Gross Division), there will be a hole-by-hole playoff on the course using the format for Round 2. In the event of a tie in any other division, there will be a "scorecard playoff" following the USGA recommended procedure found on Page 403 of the "Official Guide". Teams are limited to one prize and will receive the higher of the two. If the prizes are equal, GROSS will take precedent.

**All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, Notice to Competitors and the following local rules. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.**

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Boundaries are defined and/or identified by white stakes and property fences. Lines define the Out of Bounds if lines and stakes are used.

**PENALTY AREAS:** When stakes and lines are used to mark a penalty area, the stakes *identify* while the lines *define* the margin. When stakes are used to identify an area of long, unmown grass, the mow line defines the penalty area.

**GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are considered ground under repair:

- (1) All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds – **No Play Zones.**
- (2) All bare, un-circled areas from which trees have been removed. The margin of the GUR is the grass line.  
NOTE: Any stump that has not been ground out is a short tree.
- (3) Mowed down area of (formerly) long grass left of #3 green defined by the mow line.

**PACE OF PLAY:** The MGA Pace of Play policy posted on the Championship webpage is in effect. Please make sure you maintain position with the group in front of you on the course at all times.

**SCORING:** As required by Rule 23.2b, "Each score must be clearly identified as the score of the individual partner who made it; if this is not done, the side is **disqualified.**" (The Committee must know which player made the score that is to count for the team.)

**PRACTICE ON PUTTING GREEN OF HOLE LAST PLAYED:** Prohibited per MGA Terms of Competition. **Penalty: Two strokes on the player in breach of the Rule at the next hole.**

**DRINKING WATER:** Drinking water stations are found at various locations as well as at the Clubhouse.

**REST STATIONS:** Portable toilets or restroom facilities are found at or near the teeing areas for holes #2, 5, 7, 12, 15 and 18.
