Ability and willingness to work in an office environment independently and as part of a team

• Not a professional golfer, per eligibility requirements of the internship program

General Duties:

 Assist Assistant Executive Director in a wide range of areas including general office administration, human resources, technology and benefits administration

• Support accounting department with daily projects including accounts receivable, accounts payable, billing, and month-end processing

 Assist with on-site operation of MGA events and championships as needed and as primary duties allow

Provide support to other MGA departments as apparent or assigned

Compensation: \$15 per hour. Eligible for overtime after 40 hours per week.

Hours: Flexible working hours depending on candidate's availability, with opportunity for part-time or full-

time employment. Standard weekday hours: 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.

Employment: Employment period will be May/June through August/September. Start and end dates are flexible

depending on candidate's availability.
